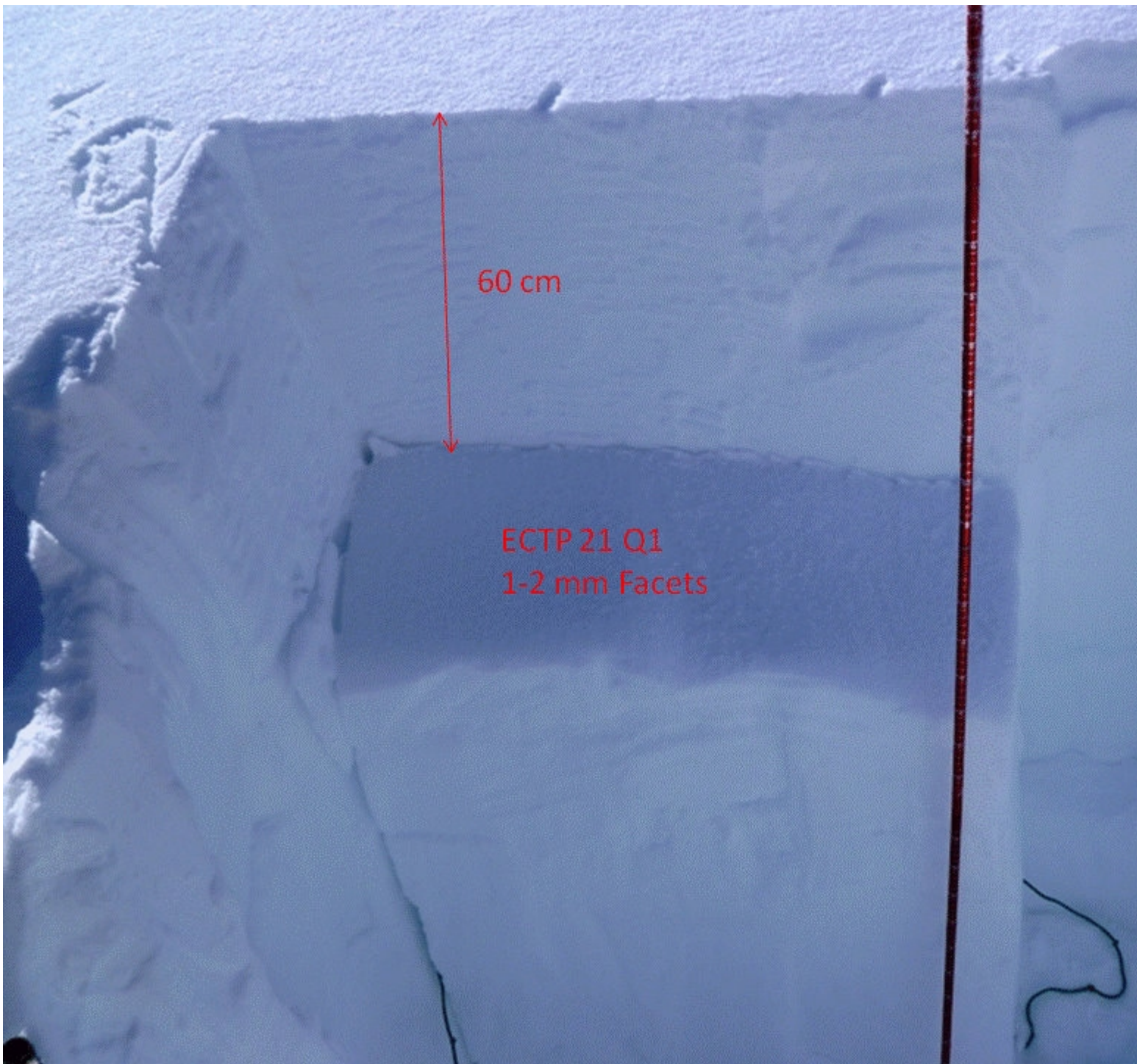




A thin layer of facets 2 feet below the surface propagated in our stability tests. This layer was found on both east and west facing slopes around 8,800 ft. A large snowstorm or wind load could make this layer reactive.
